FCSD1 Annual Report released on Wednesday

(LANDER) – The Board of Trustees of Fremont County School District 1 (FCSD1) announced today that its “2009 Report to the Community” would be released to the public this week. Copies of the 20-page report will be available at the district’s administration office at 400 Baldwin Creek Road and online at: www.fcsd1.com, on Wednesday. The report will also be delivered to district patrons in the Wednesday edition of the Lander Journal and in the Thursday edition of the Wind River News.

The report formally introduces the district’s Excellence Initiative to the public and it delivers a “report card” on student achievement in FCSD1 schools.

Trustees chairman Bruce Palmer said the annual report explains the philosophy behind the Excellence Initiative and how the district plans “to focus on every child, every day, every time.” The report spells out how students in the district have scored on statewide proficiency tests, and it reports on attendance and graduation rates. The report also contains information on various district and school programs.

“With this report, we are asking members of the community to be our partners in supporting rigorous educational standards in our schools,” said Superintendent Paige Fenton Hughes. “Our staff can inspire students to learn beyond their limits, but we also need to reinforce the importance of education at home and throughout the community.”
