LANDER VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT EXPECTATIONS FOR DRIVING ON CAMPUS 2015 – 2016

Dear Student Driver,

LVHS expects all drivers to drive responsibly on school grounds, as well as, to and from campus. Your driver's license is a privilege that we wish to extend to you at LVHS. The privilege to drive on campus comes with an expectation of responsibility.

You are expected to:

1. Be a licensed driver.
2. Visibly display parking tag from the rearview mirror so it can be viewed looking into vehicle from the windshield.
3. Follow all staff and administrative directions (administration, teachers, counselors, custodial staff, paraprofessionals, etc.).
4. Follow all traffic signs. Speed limit in the parking lot is 15 mph.
5. Park ONLY IN STUDENT DESIGNATED AREAS. Student parking is limited to the area in front of LVHS.
6. Refrain from turning donuts, speeding, excessive acceleration, passing other vehicles, riding in the back of truck beds, passing school busses, driving carelessly, driving diagonal across the lot, and any manner of driving that is not safe.
7. Students MAY NOT sit in automobiles, play loud music or loiter in the parking lot at any time.
8. Do not park in posted "NO PARKING, FIRE LANES, HANDICAPPED, BUS ZONE, VISITOR or RESERVED PARKING" in front of LVHS.
9. Give pedestrians the right of way.
10. NO STUDENTS are allowed to park in the Staff Parking at any time including before and after school, and activities during regularly scheduled school hours.
11. LVHS is not responsible for any thefts, accidents, vandalism, or destruction of property. Report such incidents to the Main Office, SRO, and local Police Department (332-3401). Protect your car and contents! KEEP YOUR VEHICLE LOCKED AT ALL TIMES.

Students who drive on campus will be required to read and sign the attached acknowledgement form regarding driving expectations and vehicle search.

Students choosing to drive irresponsibly can expect to be held accountable for their behaviors.

Consequences may include:

1. Warning
2. Tuesday/Thursday School
3. Parking lot fines
4. Loss of driving privilege for LVHS campus
5. Trespass notice
6. Submit a report to Law Enforcement for proper handling
7. Vehicle may be towed at owner's expense
