Since the pandemic, Fremont County School District #1's Child Nutrition Department has been operating off federal waivers that allowed us to feed every child for free. Unfortunately, the waivers were not extended to the 2022–2023 school year. What this means:

- ❖ School lunch and breakfast will go back to how we operated in 2019-2020 with free & reduced, and paid categories.
- ❖ Starting August 2022, **no meals will be free** unless you qualify for free and reduced-price school meals.
