

Fall 2020 Afterschool & Early Bird Plan

This plan includes the specific details for the Lights On Afterschool & Early Bird programs when FCSD#1 is operating at Tier 1. It is for students who attend school at Gannett Peak Elementary and Baldwin Creek Elementary in person. While this plan is specific to Lights On, it is under the larger more comprehensive FCSD#1 Smart Start Plan. Both of these plans are subject to change based on recommendations from WHD, WDE and/or FCSD#1 Board of Trustees.

Registration	Parents must complete one registration form for each student attending Lights On.
Class Size	 Class size will be limited 15 kindergarten 20 1st-5th grade classrooms Classes will be filled based on the order of registrations received. Once a class is full, students will be put on a wait list based on the order of registrations. Spots cannot be given away to another student; LO will determine who fills available spots.
Attendance	 Students will be expected to attend at least 80% of the day in order to keep their spot in the class. Exceptions will be made for appointments or illness.
Behavior	 If a student is suspended from LO, they will lose their spot and be moved to the waitlist.
Arrival	 Gannett Peak students will walk to Lights On with a staff member Baldwin Creek students will ride the bus to Lights On Parents will not be allowed to drop students off
Dismissal	 Parents/guardians may pick-up students anytime after 4:00 pm unless pre-arrangements have been made Before 5:15, parents will enter the SE doors, sign-out their

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	 student in the vestibule and then wait outside for their student. After 5:15, all students will be picked up at the NE door and must be picked up no later than 5:30; parents will come to the door and staff will bring the student to the parent; parents will not be allowed inside Late Pick Up-students who are picked up more than 10 minutes late 2 times will lose their spot on the 3rd occurrence There will be NO BUSSES after the program; all students will need to walk home or be picked up
Health Screening	 Students who exhibit symptoms (Cough,Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, A fever of 100.0°F or higher, Chills, New loss of taste or smell,Muscle or body aches, Nausea/vomiting/diarrhea, Congestion/runny nose (not related to seasonal allergies), Unusual fatigue) will be isolated at LO (gymnasium). Parents will be asked to pick up ill students within 30 minutes of being notified. Parents will call upon arrival to the school and we will walk the student to the parking lot. Students sent home with COVID-19 symptoms may return to LO once a physician's release is presented.
Snacks	 Snacks will be provided in the classrooms. No outside food will be permitted. Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle as only the water fillers on the fountains will work (no mouth drinking).
Face Coverings	 Face masks or shields will be required when students can not be 6 feet apart. This will include the bus from BCE to LO. Students may bring their own (bandanas will not be permitted). Face Shields may be worn.
Transitions	 Students will remain in their classroom for Power Hour and Enrichment. Classes will rotate for restroom and frequent handwashing.
Sanitation	 Hand sanitizer is located outside of each classroom. High touch surfaces will be cleaned frequently. Common spaces will not be used (gym and library). Materials sharing will be limited.
Early Bird at Gannett Peak	 Limited to 20 students with masks
Early Bird at Baldwin Creek	 Limited to 9 students with masks
